## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students must be regular and punctual to school. Each student will be allowed to appear in the final examination only if he/she maintains a minimum of 80% attendance. Regular or irregular absence without prior permission from the school authority will lead to stem disciplinary action.
2. The parents of boarders must submit a medical fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner. Periodical medical checkup by doctors will be conducted and if found necessary the parents will be intimated for further course of action.
3. Ornaments and costly belongings must be avoided inside the hostel school campus/classroom.
4. Monthly fee and bus fee is to be paid before 5th of every month.
5. Students must keep their uniform neat and clean. There will be periodic checking to ensure proper maintenance of uniform, nail and shoes.
6. All the students must attend the morning assembly without fail.
7. The Parents/Guardians of the boarders are permitted to visit their wards only on second Saturday of every month with prior permission from the Chairman, Principal Hostel warden, parents are requested not to bring any edibles while visiting their wards as they are provided with balanced and nutritious food.
8. The school authorities will take all precautionary measures to ensure the safety of the students in the school campus/premises.
9. Marketing is allowed for the boarders once in a month to purchase personal items/belongings in the presence of parents or hostel warden.
10. For any outgoing (without school authorities), the parents should come personally or should send no objection letter to the Chairman-cum- Principal. The school authorities will not be responsible for such outing programmers.
11. Day scholars and boarders must strictly follow the rules and regulations for the smooth functioning of the school. Any kind of misbehavior or indiscipline will invite severe action by the school authorities.
12. Any legal matter is subjected to North Lakhimpur Jurisdiction only.
